

Trading Card Instructions

#1 – Upload a picture of you. Click on Browse to choose a photo from your computers local files. If you have a Flickr or Facebook account, you can choose to select a photo from one of those.

**This will require additional steps not covered in these instructions.*

#2 – Choose a color for your card. Click the radio button next to the color option you want.

#3 – Enter your name in the title box, you can include a subtitle if you choose but it is not required. In the description box enter whatever statistics you think are interesting about yourself

(ideas include marital status; # of family members; unique talents; favorite vacations, foods, cars, etc.; dreams, goals – anything that you want to share that makes you who you are!

#4 – Choose icons that represent you. Click on the grey circles to choose an icon. This is optional, you don't have to include any if you don't want to.

#5 – Click submit to see your trading card! When your card appears click Save above the image to save it to your local computer. If you want to change something on your card click Edit.

** Once you have saved your trading card, include it in your introduction blog post by clicking on the insert image icon in the blog post window.
